


uPVC Door Adjustments Guide A clear, practical guide that allows you to make adjustments to your uPVC Doors with ease.

Lateral Adjustments to a Door

The door sash can be moved left and right in the frame by +/-4mm, so you can move the sash closer or further away from the lock style.



Make adjustments to the hinge positioning after installation to make sure the lock engages properly.



- Make adjustment with an allen key.
- D Once the centre hinge has been adjusted laterally, replace the cover and open and close the door to make sure it is engaging.




- Once it's engaged, and the handle comes up to the 11 o'clock potion, lock it with a key.
- If you need to make an adjustment on the top or bottom hinge, the same principle is used to adjust the door laterally as required.

Pop the centre cover off on the centre hinge, allowing you to make hinge adjustments laterally.


Vertical Adjustments to a Door

The door sash can be moved up and down in the frame by +/-4mm, so you can move the sash closer or further away from the head of the frame.



Remove bottom cover cap off using the same

alan key to make the adjustment up or down as the hinge is centrally position at the factory.





Once the centre hinge has been adjusted, open and close the door to make sure the lock is engaging. Once you are happy, replace the bottom cover cap.



Once the vertical and lateral adjustments have been made to the hinges, you need to open the door and tighten up two locking screws top and bottom of each hinge. This allows you to fix the changes you have made.
